



## AKI 2021 – Pop Up Card



Think about all the things you want to try and do in the future, create a pop-up card to share your dreams with your loved ones and remind yourself that you can do it!

Recommended for: Students in Grades 4-8th

You will need the following materials:

- 1 sheets of colored construction paper
- 2 sheets of white construction paper
- Scissors
- Glue stick
- Scotch tape
- Washable markers
- Pencil

How to create your Pop-Up Card:

1. Fold one sheet of your white construction and your colored construction paper in half: “hamburger style”.
2. Take your folded sheet of white construction paper and turn it so the fold is on the left side and the opening is on your right.
3. While the paper is folded, trace your fingers on the paper to draw three sets of 2 parallel lines. You’ll want two lines towards the bottom, two lines towards the middle, and two lines towards the top of the folded edge.
  - You can trace different fingers for different sizes or the same finger for all of the lines!
4. Now use your scissors to cut each of the lines, only go as far as you traced your fingers and fold all the sections to one side and reverse fold all the sections to the other side.
5. Gently open your card and invert the folds to be on the inside of the card so they are “popping out”.
6. Now, on your second sheet of white paper, draw pictures of three things that you would like to do or become in the future, then cut them out. You can use the white space on the inside of your card to write a description about each of your pictures too!
7. Using scotch tape, tape the three cutouts to the inverted folds that are “popping out” in your card.
8. Using your glue stick put glue on the outside of the white card and glue it inside your sheet of colored construction paper that is folded in half.
9. Use your markers to make a title for your card and decorate the outside!
